Insentra has recently partnered with CEMAsys, a leading provider of ESG Solutions, where we will work together to elevate Insentra's environmental policies. Given our position in the market, Insentra has recognized **Greenhouse Gas Emissions** and **Waste Management** as two highly relevant environmental concerns. Therefore, we have focused this section of our Environmental Policy on these core risks.

3. GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

a. Insentra is pledging to continuously monitor our energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions through our partnership with CEMAsys. This will first start off by measuring all greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions at Insentra. Insentra will measure their GHG emissions by following the Greenhouse Gas Protocol, which is a comprehensive global standardized frameworks to measure and



manage greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from private and public sector operations, value chains and mitigation actions. By measuring our greenhouse gas emissions starting from our baseline, we can effectively control and minimize emissions in the coming years. This involves identifying emission hotspots, using renewable energy, and optimizing strategies to lower our future emissions. With our baseline emissions set, we will work towards setting a reduction target for our emissions, which will be publicly reported once finalized. Additionally, once our base year emissions are set, we will hold a companywide meeting to discuss our emissions and upcoming reductions for energy consumption moving forward.

4. WASTE MANAGEMENT

a. Insentra commits to managing waste streams and reducing our waste products by purchasing reusable products and recycling products wherever possible. Insentra will achieve this by encouraging reducing, reusing and recycling, wherever possible. This will be a part of our internal training on sustainable practice so our crew members will understand what materials can be reduced, reused, and recycled. This training will take place in December of each year.

5. IN THIS POLICY, INSENTRA ADDITIONALLY COMMITS TO:

- Understanding and managing our environmental risks with the goal of minimising or eliminating those risks when additional core risks are identified;
- b. Complying with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements;
